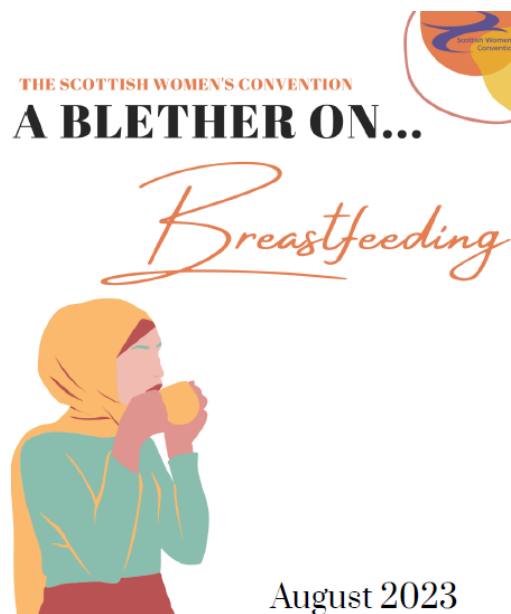


A Blether on... Breastfeeding

World Breastfeeding Week is held between the 1st and 7th of August each year, with the aim of highlighting the benefits of breastfeeding, as well as the structural

inequalities which make breastfeeding difficult for women across the world. In order to understand whether these inequalities impacted the women of Scotland, we held an online discussion on the 1st of August, with multiple themes arising: a lack of information and support, employment, sexualisation and poverty.
